Happy 181st birthday to the Texas government! The first Congress of the Republic of Texas met in October 1836, in a large dogtrot house located in Columbia-on-the-Brazos (today's West Columbia). After Texas achieved statehood in 1845, the 20 senators and 66 representatives of the Texas Legislature convened the first regular session from February 16 to May 13, 1846, in a single-story wooden structure that stood at Eighth and Colorado. The state's first capitol was completed in 1853, and the current Texas State Capitol opened in 1888.
