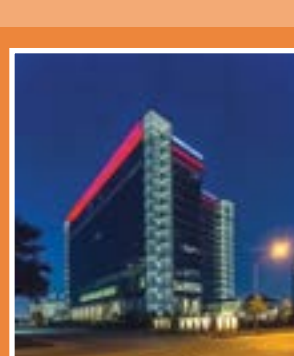

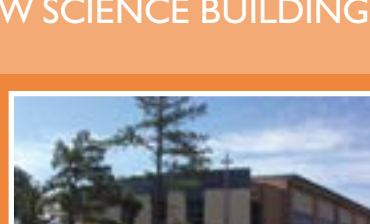

## DID YOU KNOW?

The Texas Constitution requires a bill to be read on three separate days in each house before it can go into effect.

- The first reading of a bill occurs when the bill is introduced and referred to a committee.
- The second reading occurs when the bill has been heard by a committee, favorably reported, the author has moved that all necessary rules be suspended to consider the bill on the floor, and the members of the body have approved the motion by the requisite vote.
- In order for a bill to be read the third time on the same calendar day, an affirmative vote of four-fifths of the members present is required.

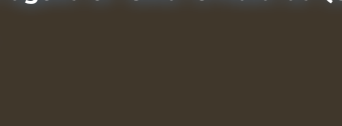
