Maintain Social Distancing

LUNCH BREAK

- Do not congregate in lunch or break areas.
- When taking breaks and lunch, avoid large groups, keep the group size to less than ten (10) people, and keep a personal space between others of at least 6 feet).
- Dispose of food and drink containers in proper receptacles - do not leave lying around.
- Clean common areas before and after use.

JOBSITE DISTANCING

- Limit physical contact with others. Try to keep a personal space to at least 6 feet when possible.
- Avoid wandering the job site and visiting non-critical areas.
- Properly locate the placement of tools, equipment, and materials to minimize job site travel and person-to person encounters.

MEETINGS

Safety Meetings are considered essential internal meetings. When Toolbox safety meetings and Daily TAC / JSA meetings are held, the size of the meeting group will be limited to 10 or fewer employees, when possible, and the supervisor will record attendance rather than having employees signing in. This can generally be accomplished by crew leaders holding their meeting with their own individual crews. During these meetings workers must maintain at least six feet of social distance separation at all times. In addition, these same requirements should be applied during breaks and lunch periods.
