Governor Abbott Shows Support for Construction Industry with New Executive Order on Essential Services



by <u>Ben Westcott</u> **2:45 p.m.** -- This afternoon the Texas Governor issued a new Executive Order, GA-14, declaring the Department of Homeland Security CISA definition for "essential services" serving critical infrastructure as the statewide definition for essential services. He declared that any local orders in conflict with this definition of "essential services" are void.
